Reflections

"Don't Overcomplicate Your Resolution"

Every year, many Christians set out for the goal of reading through the Bible in a year. It's a wonderful mission that is extremely rewarding. I commend those that take it up, and I commend more strongly those that are still at it past Leviticus! If this is your goal this year, grab a partner who calls/texts you each day and holds you to the task!

But I have another goal for you whether or not you are taking up that mission. You see, yearly Bible reading plans often leave the reader overwhelmed, bogged down, and even feeling like they didn't actually get anything out of what they read.

Consider this simple remedy/resolution: **identify** a character trait of God that is displayed in your daily reading (whether one single verse or from five chapters!) and **pray** about that attribute for 1+ minutes. Then, 1) look for ways you see that trait of God throughout your day, 2) tell yourself why you need that trait from Him throughout your day, and 3) seek ways you can emulate that trait yourself.

Example from a random verse (I literally Googled 'random Bible verse generator'!): "But I received mercy for this reason, that in me, as the foremost, Jesus Christ might display his perfect patience as an example to those who were to believe in him for eternal life." (1 Tim. 1:16). 1)God's mercy toward me is driven by His patience for me, who sins against Him. 2) God is more merciful to me than I am merciful to myself. If God has forgiven me for _____, why can't I? 3) God, help me be merciful and patient to those that may not deserve it today, because that's what you've given me in Christ.

Don't overcomplicate a resolute heart this year!
