Reflections

"Regular Check-ups"

The body isn't perfect. It's on a one-way road of decay, no matter who you are. I was watching a sitcom in which the episode's main plot followed the physically pristine main character's personal plight when he was told some ego-devasting news: his cholesterol was a little high. Devastated and feeling hopeless, he was comedically reminded of a harsh reality: even the best of bodies have imperfections and blind spots.

We all know the need of the occasional check-up. It's good for our physical well-being to be given the bad news. We need to know that cholesterol needs to be monitored, that the diet needs to be controlled, that your heart needs exercise, and the list goes on and on. It is good to be informed of the areas in which our bodies need work, especially when we are unable to see for ourselves those needs.

You may already see the parallel to be made. If regular check-ups are needed for your temporal body, don't you think regular check-ups are needed for your eternal soul? For your spiritual well-being? Isn't one more *real* than the other?

Young and old, we all need to have someone in our lives who can help us see the blind spots. You need that person (that isn't your spouse) to be able to tell you where you're lacking patience, self-control, and gentleness. You need the person (again, not your spouse!) who you've given jurisdiction to give you the bad news for your good.

Do you have that person? When was your last check-up? Ask them for their honesty and their grace.

And be reminded that though this body is irreversibly growing old and wasting away, God is renewing in you what is *really* real.

So we do not lose heart. Though our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day.
