Reflections

"The Grace Account"

One theme you may have heard in my preaching is "grace abuse." In short, grace abuse is when we use the love, grace, and forgiveness of God (once saved, always saved) as a reason to lack devotion in the way we live our lives.

Grace is not a checking account; it is an emergency fund. Picture a child with a bank account. The child is foolish with their money, but they have a father who would never ever let them go without a meal or a bed. The father is ultimately an emergency fund of love and grace for the child who fails to exercise wisdom. It would be foolish and unloving toward the father for the child to overspend daily and willingly, knowing the father would be a sucker ready to bail him her out, becoming the subject of the child's abuse. The proper response would be that the child —in love— strive to spend wisely out of love for the father, still failing at times, but ultimately growing and maturing into a person exercising daily wisdom still grateful for the security of the Father's grace.

We are the child. God is our Father. He stands ready to offer grace when we fail, but His desire is that we would love Him enough that we not abuse His grace fund.

You stand permanently delivered from the wages of sin, rescued from the consequences of your daily error, ongoing recipients of the emergency grace you desperately need. May you now strive to live a life responsible of the calling you've been given, but ultimately backed by the infinite account of grace afforded to you at the cross.
