Reflections

"The Rose"

A pastor in Texas named Matt Chandler once used an illustration that stuck with me. He told a story of a pastor at a youth event, who was teaching about sexual purity. The pastor held up a rose while he described its beauty. He instructed the hundreds of students to pass the rose one-by-one up and down the rows until it reached the last person and came back to the pastor.

"Really experience it. Look at it. Smell it. Touch it. Behold its beauty, " he said. But when the rose finally got back to him, he held it up and it didn't look as it did before it was handled by so many. Stem broken, pedals bent and falling off, etc. He then held it up again and said, "Now who would want this?" Matt Chandler telling that story then interjected, "JESUS WANTS THAT ROSE! THAT'S THE POINT OF THE GOSPEL!"

Chandler is right. What that pastor thought was a profound point of sexual purity was actually a display of saddening gospel ignorance.

Our hearts tell us that we are unlovable, worthless, unforgivable, etc., but God's voice is louder and truer than that voice in our own hearts (1 John 3:20). God loves—and sent his Son to claim as his own the adulterer, the slanderer, the gossip, the thief, the wounded, the sick, and the guilty. You may feel like a mangled and bruised rose asking, "Who would want me?" My encouragement today is to remind you of a beautiful truth: Jesus wants the rose.
