# Reflections

**Pastor Caleb Hughes** 

'Parade of the Nations"

At the time that I am writing these words, the country of Afghanistan is being overtaken by the Taliban. This is a tragedy from near any angle conceivable. As an American, it is a tragedy to see a near twenty year war "end" in despair. As a human being, it is a tragedy to consider the humanitarian crisis awaiting the Afghani people under the reign of an entity known for subjecting people to violence, poverty, and even death; it is especially a crisis for women and children. But as a Christian, it is a special kind of crisis.

Those people mentioned above bear the same image of God that you and I do. It was heartbreaking to see the images of U. S. military planes jammed full of refugees only to consider the ones not able to board, or cling to the exterior of the plane for dear life as they would later fall to their death.

But the people at the forefront of my mind are the Christians still in Afghanistan. I spoke with an IMB missionary, who told me that the underground church in Afghanistan is fervently devoted to the cause of Christ. They are strong. In the coming weeks and months, many will die because they are strong.

Church, take a moment today and in the weeks to come to pray for our brothers and sisters that we cannot stand with in body but that we can stand with in Spirit. Pray that the same Spirit that strengthened Stephen in Acts 7 would strengthen God's church in Afghanistan, to boldly cling to their true Treasure, even if it means meeting Him soon. Pray for the gospel to go forth and save and that the blood of the martyrs would be the fuel of Christ's church as it has been for millennia.

Heaven will be a parade of the nations, whose shouts of triumph center not on a national creed or anthem but the anthem of our Lord Jesus: It is finished! Maranatha, come. O Lord!
