Reflections

"Operation Faithfulness"

One of my favorite things local churches do annually is Operation Christmas Child. We are once again taking part, and I expect that this month, many of you will began filling your boxes to send off to be a blessing to a child you will never meet—at least I hope you do!

A few years ago, the church I pastored sent a few hundred boxes, as they normally did. The fruit from that ministry is not in seeing the gifts received but in faithfully sending the gifts. Well, that year God chose to show us the fruit of a tangible result. One day I received a letter that was creased and dirty, but the return address scribbled on the envelope was clear: "Philippines." Etched in pencil on a sheet of notebook paper were words of gratitude, thanksgiving, and godward praise.

I shared the letter with my church, because I saw it for what it was: an unexpected tangible piece of fruit despite the blessing of obedience not requiring or expecting it. But here's the truth: only a dozen or so boxes reached that village in the Philippines; meanwhile, I know that God was using 300+ other boxes to profoundly bless other impoverished children—and those are the stories we never heard. The work of God in the "meanwhile."

We all like to see the tangible results of our obedience, but the primary fruit of obedience is not the tangible result; it is the fruit of faithful living. The measurement of faithfulness while representing Jesus every day in your workplace, home, and school, representing him to your coworkers, friends, and family, is not a measurement of tangible results but of **personally faithful living**. And the good news? You can always trust God to be working in the "meanwhile."
