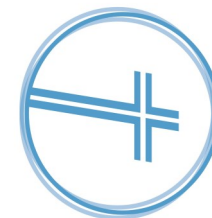

Reflections

The Gift of Gray

As I write today, I'm under the weather and working at my home office desk. Well, not so much a "desk" as it is a bathroom countertop (not a lot of quiet places in the Hughes house). While it is mostly quiet, there is one major drawback: every time I look up I have a sickly, bespectacled, mouth-breathing, cough-drop sucking, eye-sagging face looking back at me (a mirror if you didn't follow that inner monologue). I'm mostly being dramatic, but something in seeing my reflection did draw me to a comforting biblical truth today.

The Bible draws a hard and comforting contrast for the believer. Paul uses that contrast in referring to his own constant physical imprisonment but also for a church in Corinth that would daily see the fleeting and vain thing it is to cling too tightly to this physical life, this physical body. Here is Paul's contrast: *"Though our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day. For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison,"* (2 Cor. 4:16-17). While our bodies are moving one direction, for the believer, our inner self (mind, soul, spirit) is moving a different direction.

I look in the mirror and see thinner hair on my head and a grayer beard than I saw last year. A wasting away outer self. But as I look inward, I see God's gift: a year's worth of knowledge, wisdom, experience, love, faith, growth, etc. I'll let you determine which of those has greater long-term value.

The point is that each additional gray hair, wrinkle, pain, sickness, trial, and loss is a gift, not because of what they do to your outer self, but because of what God is doing in your inner self. They are reminders that you are one day nearer to glory—that God is renewing your inner self day by day, preparing you for glory beyond all comparison.

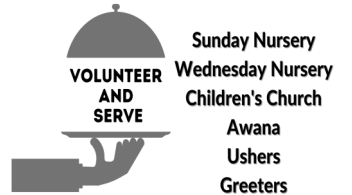

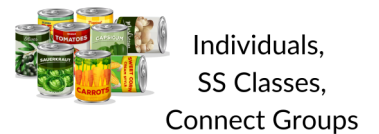

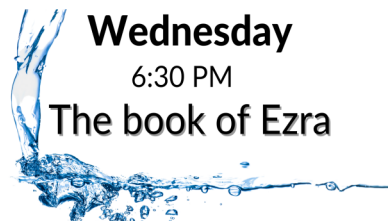
