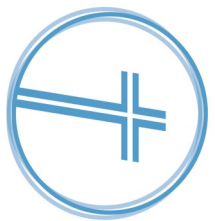

"Not Your Average Carpenter"

This week I saw a post online that mentioned the meekness of a manger birth. The King of glory's first resting place was in a cheap wooden cradle. When I pondered this, my mind went where maybe yours does. What humility and love that the incarnate deity would take on such lowly birth!

Then I had a realization. **The wooden cradle that supported Jesus as he drew his first breaths only looked forward to the wooden cross that supported him as he drew his last breaths.** A lowly entry and a lowly exit, and yet—on each occasion—we read what shepherds and centurions observed: a Savior, Christ the Lord, the Son of God.

The message of Christmas is the message of Easter, the message of the gospel.

"Mild He lays His glory by, Born that man no more may die; Born to raise the sons of Earth, Born to give them second birth..... Peace on earth and mercy mild, God and sinners reconciled."

Jesus began life cradled by wood, lived his life as a woodworker, and his final work was proclaimed and completed on a cross of wood—"It is finished."
