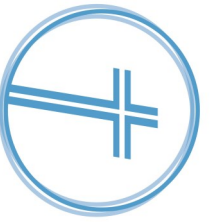

The Good Treasure

A few nights ago, Brooke and I were sitting quietly eating at the dinner table, while our two youngest children (nearly 2 and nearly 4) were sitting with their backs to us eating at the bar. Brooke and I smiled at one another because of what we heard from the two little ones. They were singing. They were not singing the same song nor were they attempting to sing together. They just love to sing. The youngest is a "Baby Shark" lover, and you can count on it: if that girl is singing, you're going to hear some variation go "doo doo doo" in there somewhere. You know why? **Because the song she regularly takes in is the song she puts out.**

That principle is a biblical one. "The good person out of the good treasure of his heart produces good, and the evil person out of his evil treasure produces evil, for out of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaks," (Lk. 6:45). It is foolishness to expect godliness to come out of you if God's Word is rarely going in you.

"Baby Shark" is of little reward. In fact, I think it's shaving years off of my life! But the intake of God's Word promises to be a lamp for our feet and a light to our path (Ps. 119:105). Do you want to live within the guidance and care of your Protector? May His Word be your safeguard that grants constant wisdom for your journey.

There will be days that the treasure and comfort of this world are far from you. In those days, only God can provide imperishable treasure that is unfading (1 Pet. 1:3-5). May we store it up for that day. Doo doo doo :)
